Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ): TIMS Transition

1. What is happening to TIMS? TIMS has been upgraded with a new and improved platform. Starting March 20, 2025, users will be automatically redirected from TIMS Classic to the new TIMS site.

2. What will happen to the old TIMS? The old TIMS will remain for a period of time, re-branded as TIMS Classic. This is to allow users a few months to transition. However, users are encouraged to begin using the new TIMS as soon as possible.

3. How do I access the new TIMS site? You can access the new TIMS at: <https://tims.dot.state.oh.us/tims>. Existing bookmarks to the former URL will be re-directed to this new site beginning 3/20/2025

4. How do I access TIMS Classic after the redirect begins? Even after the redirect, TIMS Classic can still be accessed directly at: https://gis.dot.state.oh.us/tims_classic.

5. What's new in the updated TIMS?

- A modernized user interface
- Enhanced tools for mapping, data analytics, and reporting
- Enhanced data glossary and metadata

10. Is GCAT available in the new TIMS? GCAT will no longer be supported in the new TIMS application. Per the direction of the ODOT Safety team, users should begin transitioning to the AASHTOWare Safety tool.
